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Visualizing a future free of Hepatitis C.

- Hepatitis C is the most common blood-borne infection in the United States with over 5 million HCV positive individuals.
- Baby Boomers represent 77% of all HCV infections.
- It is estimated that 50-75% of chronically infected individuals are unaware of their infection.
- There is a cure for Hepatitis C.

CDC recommends testing all patients born from 1945 to 1965.

Order a **“Hepatitis C Antibody with Reflex to Hepatitis C Virus RNA, Quantitative, Real-Time PCR.”**

The United State Preventative Services Task Force has given birth cohort based testing a Grade B recommendation. All major insurances should cover the cost of screening.
