



## National Viral Hepatitis Roundtable (NVHR) Advisory Committee Charter

### PURPOSE

The purpose of the NVHR Advisory Committee is to inform the strategic direction of NVHR, including policy and programmatic priorities and activities.

### COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP

The NVHR Advisory Committee is comprised of 8 individuals with personal or professional experience with viral hepatitis who have demonstrated commitment to health equity, harm reduction, and inclusion. Appointment to this committee will be made at the discretion of the HEP Executive Director and NVHR staff. Committee appointments are voluntary commitments of two years unless otherwise noted. The committee term begins September 1<sup>st</sup> and concludes August 31<sup>st</sup>. A member shall not serve more than two consecutive terms, unless otherwise approved by HEP/NVHR leadership.
