- ► Formation of Hep Free PA Viral Hepatitis Elimination Coalition
 - Under fiscal umbrella of Community Liver Alliance
 - Purpose: to develop and implement advocacy strategy that will support implementation of the viral hepatitis elimination plan
 - ▶ Identify Coalition Co-Chairs
 - Create an Advisory Committee
 - Identify and organize community members who may be impacted by the HCV and HBV epidemics
 - Host monthly Coalition meetings
 - Advocacy Efforts
 - Secure funding through grant writing and government engagement
 - Secure government endorsement of the viral hepatitis elimination plan
